2. Moby Dick Ocean-themed Quilt



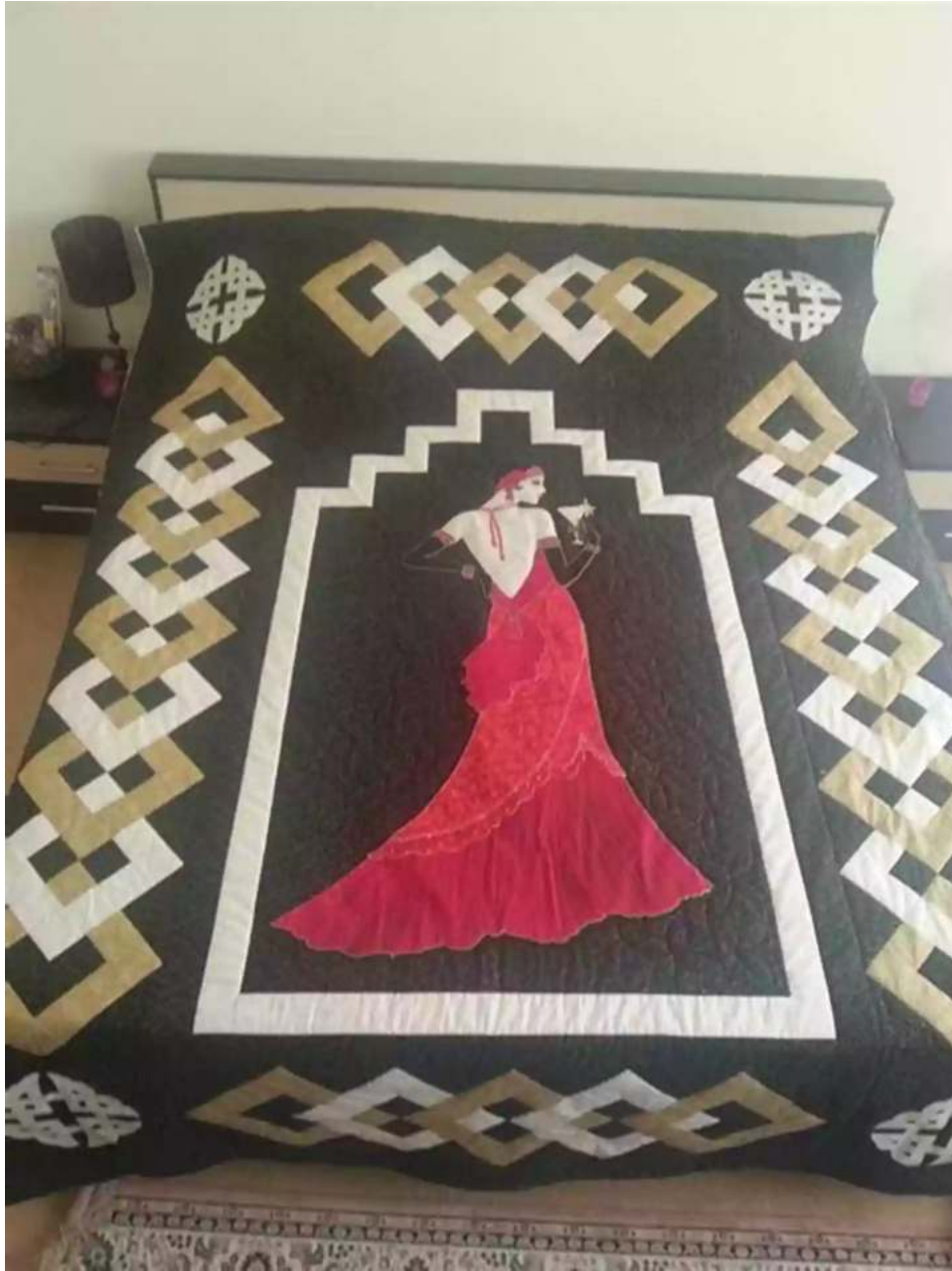
