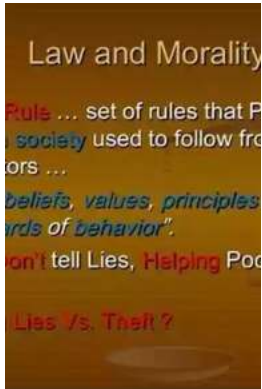
Law and Morality

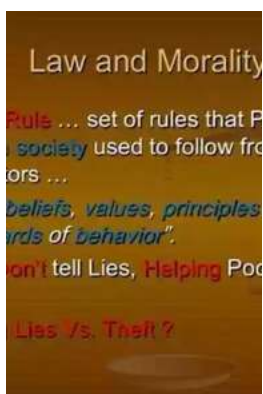

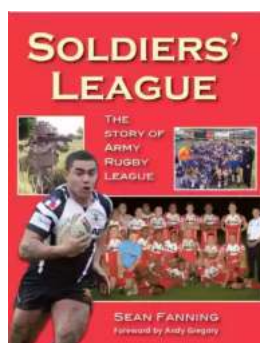

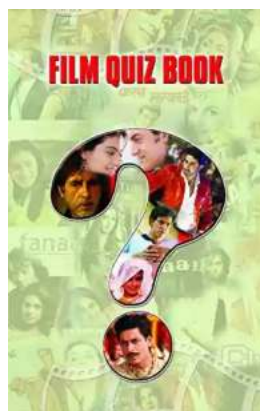
