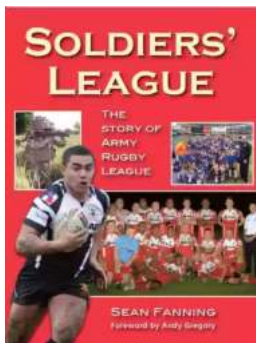

- information about public transport, directions (maps included), prices for all sites and restaurants, local events, and nighttime activities

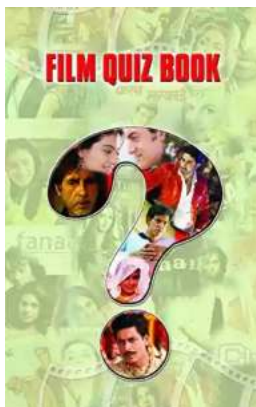
