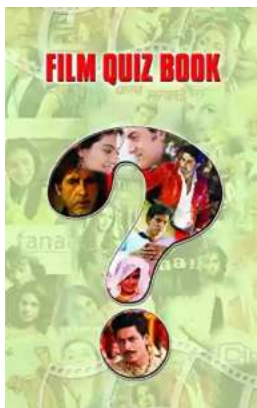
Phoebe belongs to Master Duncan and works in the plantation kitchen.
