

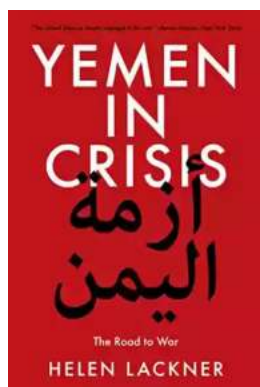
# The Unfolding Yemen Crisis: Road To War
