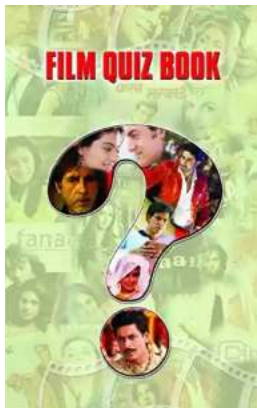
In Korea, like in China, the fight laid the historical groundwork for Korean nationalism, inspiring and exploiting nationalist opposition to Japanese

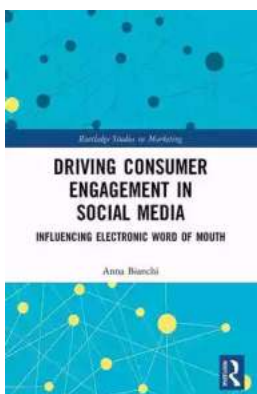
